even more strength and protection from excessive wear and tear. The I-20 Ultra is available in a complete range of sizes to address all the particular needs a landscape might have. Those who prefer a higher cut of turf on their landscapes should consider the 6-inch version, which pops up a full 2 inches higher than the standard rotors in this class. You'll get better clearance over the lawn while receiving the same degree of top-notch performance found in all other I-20 Ultra models. If you're looking to upgrade over a typical residential grade rotor, this is where the search ends.
